- Follow the diagram instructions to complete this book.

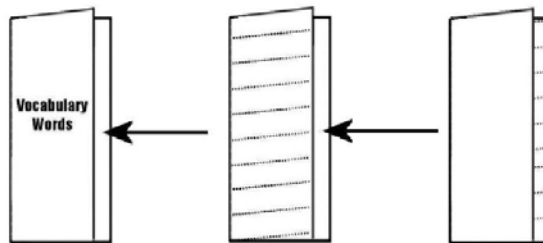
Cut both templates on dotted lines to create flaps.
