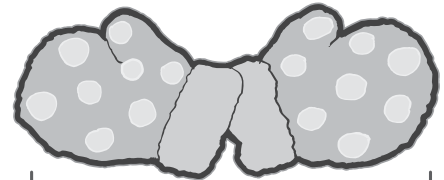

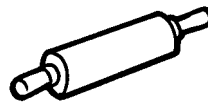

Put the ingredients in a bowl. Stir the ingredients to make the dough.



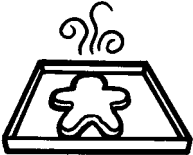
Roll out the dough on the counter. Cut out the gingerbread people.

Decorate the gingerbread people.

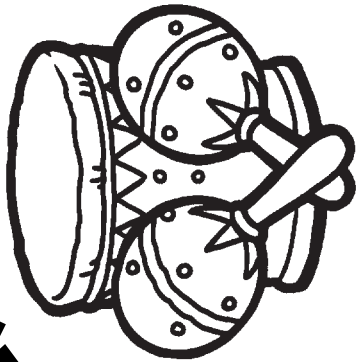


Take the gingerbread people out of the oven and let them cool.



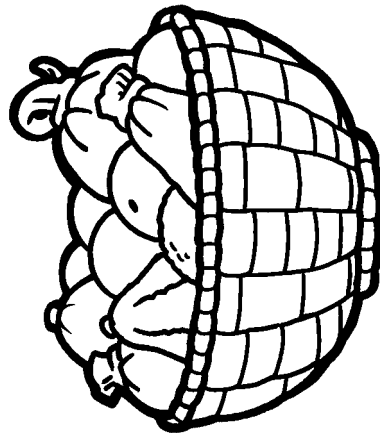

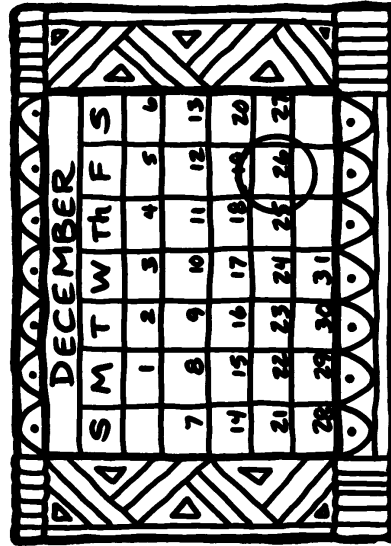

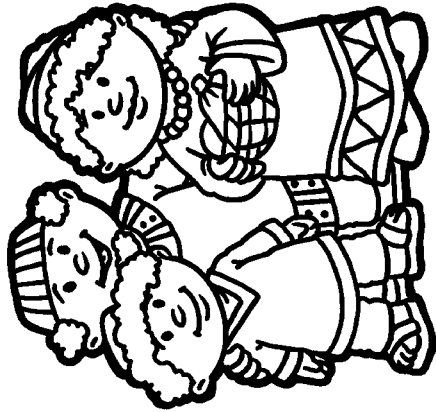
